Guidelines, Requirements and policy

1. Quincenera will be celebrated at 12 pm on the second Saturday of the month. There can be up to only four quinceneras (girls) in one celebration. It is not a full mass. It involves, liturgy of the word, renewal of baptismal vows, prayer of consecration by the quincenera, blessing, *Holy Communion* and final blessing.
2. Plan on having rehearsal the day before the celebration, a short class and introduction to the celebration will be offered. Attendance is mandatory.
3. Plan a meeting with the coordinator at least 30 days before the celebration to plan the liturgy.
4. We don't allow limousines on the compound.
5. For group quinceneras, each person pays the above donation to the church but the choir fee is shared.
