Today's readings demonstrate the gratuitous nature of God's love for humanity. Recognizing this benevolence, we, along with the Magi, prostrate ourselves and pay homage by offering our supreme gifts – our faith, hope and love – in the service of our generous, loving God.

Sacred Heart Catholic School has truly been blessed! This marks the third year that we have received a grant for Bricks, Mortar, and Technology from the Salem Catholic Schools Foundation. Year one we received \$85,000 for library shelves, four roof top heat units, double doors at the back of gym, the new front entrance to the school, a \$7,500 matching grant for computers in lab, three document cameras with projectors, and a cart of twenty iPads in a charging cart. Year two we received \$57,000 for three more rooftop heat units, column protectors for the covered play shed posts (50% and 50% from Archdiocesan Safety First Grant), and money to set up our Pre-school classroom. Year three we received \$69,000 for another charging cart with twenty iPads, 50% of the cost to replace the electrical panels in the school and the gym kitchen (the other 50% came from the Archdiocesan Safety First Grant), and \$50,000 to begin remodeling the former boiler room to be the new teacher work room. Receiving these grants has truly helped Sacred Heart Catholic School to make much needed improvements to our building and helping keep up with the ever changing technology needed to improve our school program. That being said, the school still relies heavily on the support of our benefactors to help with the everyday cost of running the school. Sacred Heart-St. Louis Parish has been very supportive of Sacred Heart School for many years and the school is most grateful! Please continue to support the school with our fund raising efforts. Thank you to those who month after month use the school donation envelopes provided with the offertory envelopes. Thank you to those that purchase Scrip on a regular basis. Scrip is a great way for everyone to help the school financially without it costing them anything but the time it takes to make the Scrip purchase. Please check out the new Benefit Mobile App for Scrip purchasing! The Annual Appeal for 2016-2017 has been sent out and we are hoping to meet our goal! Plans are under way for the annual Spring Fling Auction and Dinner! Save the date...April 8...so many work hours and hours to make this a successful fund raiser! Thank you! We are so grateful for all the financial support that we have received in the past and hope that each of you will prayerfully consider helping now and in the future.

**Archbishop's Catholic Appeal Update**

The Archdiocese has received a total of \$13,074.00  
the goal being \$20,516.00. We are 64% of the way to
